Basic Operations

- Technology Operations and Concepts, W6
- Introduce** turning on a computer and logging on
 - Introduce** using a mouse to click on icons and buttons
 - Introduce** using desktop icons to open programs and menus
 - Introduce** using a keyboard. Students should be able to locate keys with both hands

- Introduce** using a word processing application or program to write, edit, print and save assignments

- Introduce** watching online videos and use the play, pause, forward and rewind buttons while taking simple notes.

 - Introduce** explaining responsible uses of technology and digital information; describe possible consequences of inappropriate use
 - Introduce** identifying cyberbullying and describe strategies to deal with such a situation
